Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach the end of the spring term, I just wanted to write to thank you for your continued support. The school has gone through significant change this academic year and we are incredibly proud of the achievements we are seeing every day.

Attendance has increased by 3.2% this year to 95.4%, and exclusions have decreased significantly by 49% compared to this time last year. Over 150 students have enjoyed Hot Chocolate Friday with the Headteacher since September, and 200 SLT Commendations have been awarded for outstanding effort, attitude and work. Nearly 200 students have received zero negative behaviour points all year, which is really positive and reflects the excellent response to the restorative approach to behaviour management we have adopted. Further achievements, efforts and progress will be recognised next week at our end-of-term rewards assemblies.
