OFSTED VISIT

In addition to the beginning of our formal exam period, we also welcomed Ofsted in the week prior to half term. The school was last inspected in February 2017 and we were joined this visit by four inspectors on Tuesday 21st and Wednesday 22nd May.

During the two days, inspectors met with senior and middle leaders, NQTs, Governors and our alternative education provider, in addition to discussions with the Local Authority. The inspectors also observed a number of lessons and held meetings with students from each year group. A huge thank you to parents who completed the online questionnaire, which was overwhelmingly positive.

We received a draft report on Monday this week and had one day to check its factual accuracy. The final report is due to be published by Ofsted in the next couple of weeks and I will write to parents with details at this point. I will also hold a meeting where parents can ask any questions.

EXAMS

We have had excellent attendance to our exams to date, which gives students the best possible chance of success. Can I encourage all parents to remind students to arrive in plenty of time in order to have a relaxed start to the exams.

We have run intervention and revision sessions before and after school, as well as during February, Easter and May holidays to give students all they support they need during this intense period.

Whilst revision is important during this time, please ensure that students are eating healthily, exercising regularly, getting plenty of water and sleep and avoiding too much screen time.
